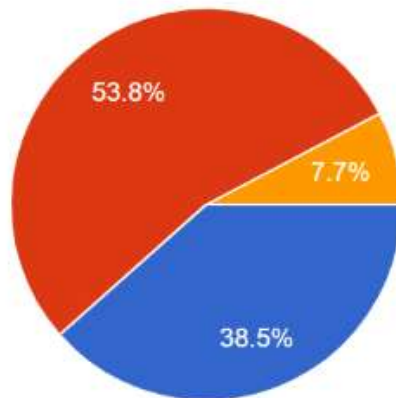

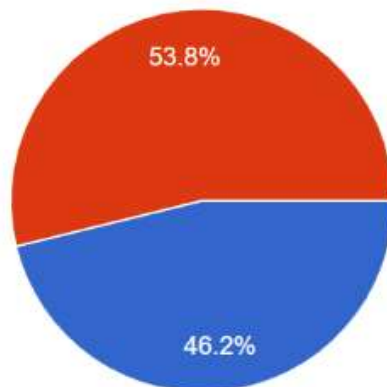

The Family Learning evening was informative



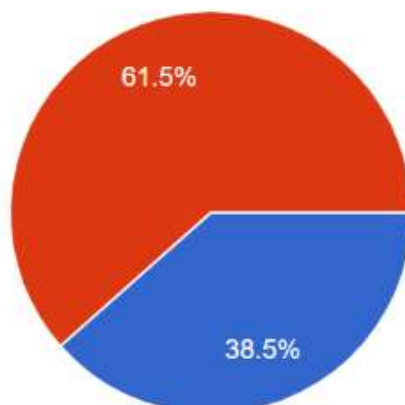
- Strongly agree

My child feels supported in Year 11



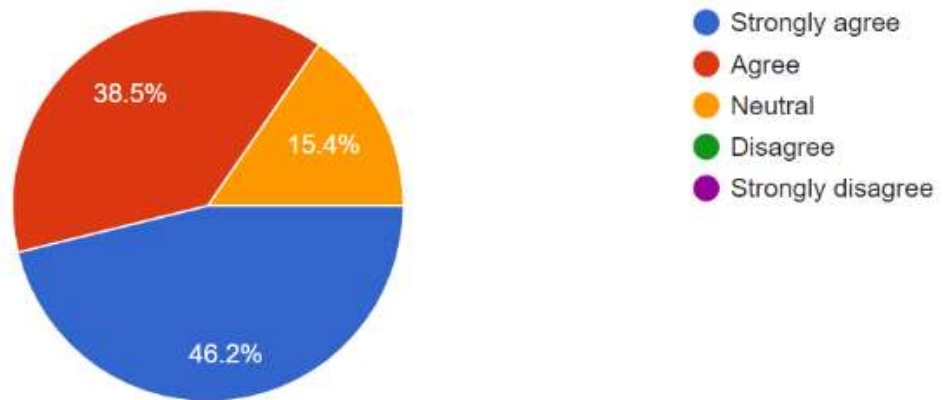

The amount of information given on the evening was

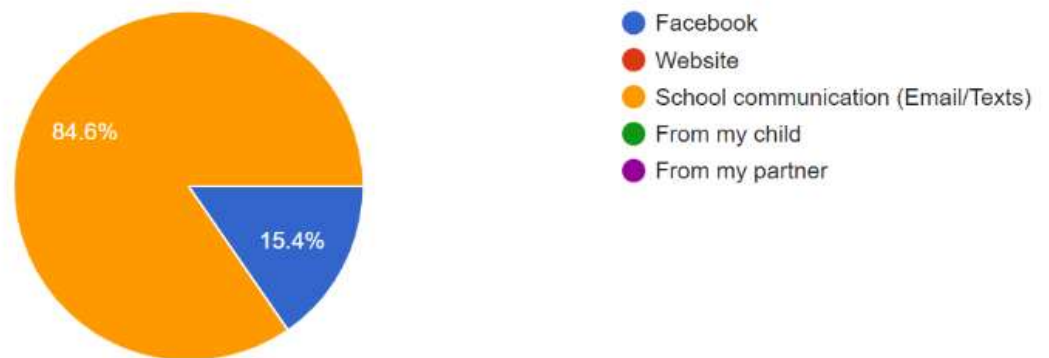


- Too much

- A series of sessions. Part of learning is understanding the learners. Much of what was delivered was crammed in, overloaded and a level of expectation from parents/carers.
- You covered everything we wanted.
- A lot of info relies on the child *being willing* to show the parent what is on their google classroom and the various resources shown in each subject. For those parents with very independent children, various tactics are used to deny that these resources are available and we are essentially locked out. In particular, a timetable that shows those revision classes they have been invited to vs those that are held for everyone.
