The School's Out Surf Camp, delivered in partnership between St Ives Bay Adventure Group and Spot-M Morocco, is a bespoke week long surf trip for UK based schools and colleges.

Located in the small yet bustling village of Mirleft in South Morocco, the trip gives students the opportunity to learn, or progress, at surfing, enjoy some African sunshine, traditional Moroccan cuisine, fantastic accommodation, enlightening workshops, all the while engaging in the amazing Berber culture within the town and surrounding area.

Key Trip Information

Location: Mirleft, Morocco. About 2 hours south of the city Agadir.

Duration: 8 days / 7 nights from 29th October - 5th November

Flights: Flying with EasyJet to Agadir from either Gatwick or Bristol, flights are 3.5 hours and are generally early on either a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday, with afternoon return flights on the same day a week later. Traditionally weekend flights are too expensive for the trip to run, however we are open to these if necessary.

Surfing: The majority of surfing takes place at Plage Sauvage, where Spot-M have a great exclusive beachside premises offering all the amenities. There is a beach break and point on location. In the event we have intermediate to advanced surfers, then we can go mobile in search of better surf should Plage Sauvage be too small or too big.

Accommodation: Exclusive Villas are used to house students, with roughly 4-5 rooms per Villa and anywhere between 2-4 students per room, and a room for supervising staff.

Food: All food for the trip is locally sourced and prepared by a small group of fantastic chefs, and includes traditional tagines, couscous, kebabs, and BBQ. Most allergies can be catered for.

VISA and vaccinations: Neither a VISA or vaccinations are required to enter Morocco.

Other activities: Artistic workshops, sand boarding, half day trip to Tiznit (jewellery capital of Morocco), experiencing an amazing sunset atop the 500-year-old French fort that sits above Mirleft, journey to the arch of Legzhira beach, group evening meal out in the town, and a final evening traditional Berber dance and buffet.
