I am pleased to tell you that our Year 10 students have made excellent progress this academic year and we would like to thank you for all that goes on behind the scenes throughout this important time in your child's education, including the support you have shown with sourcing work experience placements.

With assessment and grading changes from Key Stage 3 to Key Stage 4 you may be wondering what the numbers on your child's data sheet actually mean. We would like to invite you to a Year 10 Family Learning event on Tuesday 18 April where we will talk you through the GCSE grading system (introduced in 2017) and subjects will give you an overview of their courses.

Your child is currently working towards their GCSE/BTec subjects and we therefore feel it is crucial for you to attend this evening to help support your child with their courses to support not just with this academic year, but to set them up for success ready for their final year in school.

Staff will lead you through what your child is learning in key subject areas and provide you with a clear, specific understanding of the courses and offer practical guidance on how to support your son/daughter's learning.
