



Dear Parents and Carers,

Enrichment Week: 14 – 18 July 2025

I am writing to inform you about our plans for this year's *Enrichment Week* (formerly known as *Activities Week*). We are making a change in how we offer extracurricular trips and activities by spreading them more evenly across the school year, rather than concentrating them into a single week.

There are several reasons for this shift. The cost of international and residential trips — while enriching — can be high and, understandably, beyond the reach of many families. We believe all students should have access to high-quality experiences, and this is much easier to achieve when the normal school timetable continues.

Our aspiration is to ensure all timetabled activities are inclusive and engaging for every student. In the previous model, students' experiences during Activities Week could vary greatly depending on the cost and nature of the activities selected. We also observed a decline in uptake for out-of-school activities, which require intensive planning and staffing. For those remaining in school, maintaining enthusiasm for five days of on-site activities without the structure of a normal timetable was increasingly difficult.

As a result, we are introducing a more inclusive *Enrichment Week* in the final week of the summer term.

Plan for the Week

- **Year 10:** Work Experience (Monday – Friday)
- **Years 7 – 9:**
 - **Monday & Tuesday:** Normal timetable, with curriculum-based enrichment in lessons
 - **Wednesday–Friday:** Three rotating activity days:
 - **A Beach Day** at Pendower (transport provided by bus)
 - **A Sports Activities Day** on site
 - **A Creative Day** in partnership with Roseland staff and representatives from the Hall for Cornwall, as part of *The Roseland Festival*

Voluntary Contribution

All activities are fully inclusive, and costs will be covered by the school. This would require qualified lifeguards and equipment hire, which is beyond our current budget.
